Affidavit of Support for Undergraduate F-1 Non-Degree Students

As a non-degree student in the U.S., you are required to certify that you will have adequate financial support for the duration of your F-1 status at Pace University. A Certification of Eligibility (Form I-20) to obtain an F-1 visa will not be issued until you have completed this form and submitted it with the official bank documentation.

You can show your own bank statement, sponsoring yourself (Part I), or have a sponsor (family member or friend) who will be providing the required funds for the duration of your study at Pace University (Part II).

- Submit completed form with supporting financial documentation.
- To initiate the process, financial documentation in PDF format is acceptable; the original financial documentation should be submitted as soon as possible. Scanned PDF of original bank letter in USD, in English, and demonstrating liquid, readily accessible funds (i.e., checking or savings account) must be uploaded to ISSConnect.
- The affidavit must be less than six (6) months old upon intended date of enrollment.
- All financial documentation must be equal to or greater than the estimated living cost for duration of study.
- Please refer to Part III for the estimated living cost for the duration of study at Pace University.
